TAX CREDIT

HELP US KEEP YOUR TAX DOLLARS IN LAKE HAVASU AT THE SCHOOL OF YOUR CHOICE!

Tax Credit is a dollar for dollar subtraction from your AZ State Income Tax Liability. This is NOT a donation. It is YOUR tax money! If you don't participate, your taxes go to Phoenix and do not come back to Lake Havasu. Married people filing jointly can participate up to \$400 and singles can participate up to \$200. Your friends and family around the state can also have their tax credit funds credited to the Lake Havasu Unified School District. 100% of your tax credit dollars will go to the local school and extra-curricular activity of your choice. You pay now and take your receipt to your tax preparer. You may drop off your tax credit form and payment off at any of our local schools or at the District Office located at 2200 Havasupai Blvd., Building A, Lake Havasu City, AZ 86403. You can also mail the form to that same location. For more information about this program or to have any questions answered, contact Jackie Taylor at 505-6917. The deadline for accepting tax credit forms and payments is December 31st of each year.


